To ensure the Board functions properly

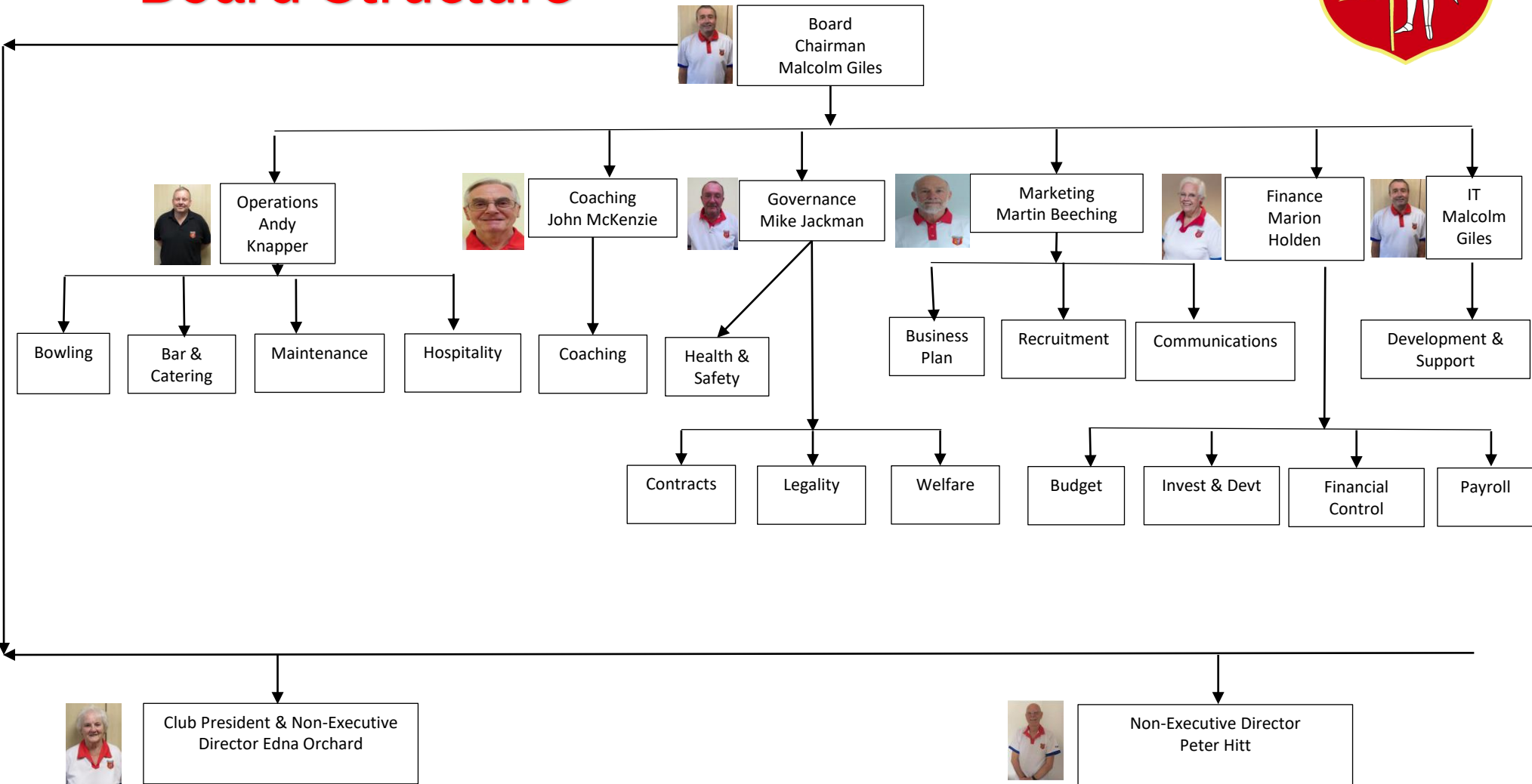
Responsible for ensuring each Board meeting is planned effectively, conducted according to the constitution and that matters are dealt with in an orderly, efficient manner.
